1. Program Overview

- Program Name: KOICA-Hallym University NEXT Fellowship in Climate-AI Convergence
- Department: Department of Climate-AI Convergence, Graduate School of Global Cooperation
- Degree: Master of Science (M.S.) in Climate-AI Convergence
- Duration: August, 2026 – August, 2028 (25 Months)
- Target Countries (13): These countries are selected by KOICA.
 - Cambodia, Mongolia, India, Egypt, Bangladesh, Vietnam, Philippines, Nepal, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, Indonesia, Uzbekistan, Pakistan
- Eligibility:
 - Citizens of the 13 designated countries with foreign national parents
 - Bachelor's degree holder.
 - Strong command of English (Speaking & Writing).
 - **Restrictions:** Previous Korean Government scholarship recipients are NOT eligible.

2. Graduation Requirements

- A practice-oriented curriculum in climate tech and AI convergence (Internship opportunities)
- Graduation Credits: Completion of at least 36 credits including all required courses
- A cumulative GPA of at least B0(3.0/4.5) across all courses
- Language Requirement (Choose one):
 - Korean: TOPIK Level 4) OR
 - English: Pass Hallym University English Test OR minimum score of TOEIC 700, TOEFL PBT 550, TOEFL IBT 80, IELTS 5.5, TEPS 550, New TEPS 300.
- Graduation Qualification (Choose one):
 - Submission and qualification of Thesis OR
 - Pass both written and oral tests for Graduation Exam covering 5 subjects
